



Our brief was to provide a contemporary home that took account of the amazing views above Baltimore and beyond to Sherkin Island as far as the Mizen Peninsula.

On a confined site bounded by neighbouring house to the west, a steep cliff to the north and a stream to the east, the plan of the house is compact without ever feeling so. The large open plan living area showcases a full wall of glass angled to absorb the views to the north west and the setting sun. A home office, utility space and winter garden complete the ground floor.

The glass wall is replicated for the master bedroom above with two further bedrooms.

The building is cruciform in shape reflecting two strong axes: the north-south views and the east-west journey through the home.
