The chapel within the home which formed part of the streetscape was renovated from an outdated, awkward space to one full of light and volume giving the residents a connection with nature through carefully selected materials, stone, wood, earth & water.

The fundamental layout of the space was altered to a more traditional arrangement allowing for a new entrance, alter and quiet, reflection space to the side. The design was complimented by bespoke furniture design and stained-glass windows
